

ANNUAL DUES

Membership dues are \$25 per year which includes International (\$7.00), District (\$5.50), and Club dues. Each member receives a t-shirt, certificate of membership, membership card, and membership pin during the year.

MEMBER IN GOOD STANDING REQUIREMENTS

To be considered a member in good standing and to be able to vote, members must:

- Pay dues by due date
- Attend club meetings. Members may not miss more than three club meetings per semester.
- Perform 30 hours of service annually with a minimum of 5 hours quarterly.
- Participate or attend two Key Club projects per semester,
- Attend one Horses and Handicap per year.
- Qualify scholastically by school district requirements.

A member in good standing is allowed to run for an officer position and vote during elections.
