On May 16, 2025 Morrow Elementary is honored to welcome members of the Federal Bar Association (FBA) - Broward County Chapter, who will be sponsoring a book fair in partnership with READ USA. They will be providing each scholar with the opportunity to select two free books. This special event will feature visits from federal judges, other federal luminaries, and District dignitaries. This will offer our scholars unparalleled opportunities to interact with the federal bench and bar outside of the courtroom. Magistrate Judges and attorneys volunteered to participate in this event to read and interact with our scholars. We hope that these interactions will spark students' curiosity about the legal profession and the judicial processes.

The Great American Bus Interactive Education (GABIE) will visit our school in May to provide hands-on STEM based science projects for the students to participate in. GABIE, provides a STEM/Agriculture curriculum based mobile, interactive, educational program that covers a multitude of standards. Students will have the opportunity to view displays of Florida's primary Agriculture and walk through the state's exciting, colorful, and interactive world of STEM/Agriculture. There will be shadow boxes of different commodities that students can touch, read its educational importance, and view videos about purpose of the commodities. The whisper mill will allow the students to engage in the process of grinding wheat seeds into flour. They will learn about technology advancement from the 13 colonies to present day America. In addition, there will be discussions about Honey Bees so students can see how the Honey Bees make honey by a chemical reaction and the importance of their role in our food supply and human survival. This immersive experience will deepen students' understanding of agriculture, science, and technology in a fun and meaningful way.

YOUR STUDENT'S FAST ASSESSMENTS ARE COMPUTER-ADAPTIVE TESTS TAKEN ON A COMPUTER OR TABLET. THE QUESTIONS GET LESS OR MORE DIFFICULT DEPENDING ON HOW A STUDENT RESPONDS, AND EACH STUDENT WILL SEE DIFFERENT QUESTIONS FROM A COMMON ITEM BANK. EACH TEST ATTEMPT (PMI, PM2, AND PM3) WILL PRESENT ITEMS THAT COVER THE ENTIRE TEST "BLUEPRINT," MEANING STUDENTS WILL ENCOUNTER ITEMS REPRESENTATIVE OF THE STANDARDS WITHIN THE SUBJECT OR GRADE LEVEL.
