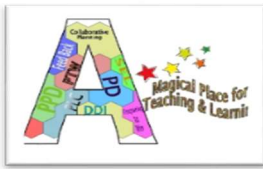

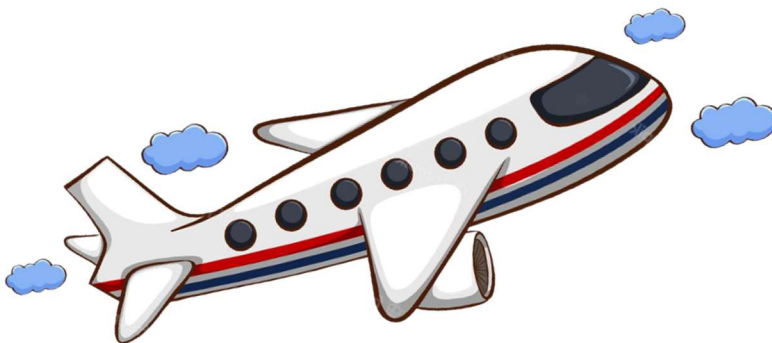

Park Lakes Survival Guide

SCHOOL HOURS:

School hours are from 8:00am-2:00pm. Students should not arrive on campus before 7:15am, as there will be no adult supervision until that time. Students must leave the campus by 2:30pm (unless there is a school function scheduled). For students **arriving for breakfast**, the cafeteria will be open at 7:15am. Students arriving for breakfast must utilize the 36th Street entrance (bridge entrance) onto campus. Please remember, every school day all students should report to class by 8:00am.

STUDENT DROP OFF PROCEDURES

Please enter through 36th Street of the park entrance and proceed all the way to the end of the lane. This will improve the flow of traffic into and exiting the campus. Please note, **the drive-through lane on 41st Street is for BUS Transportation ONLY. Parents are not permitted to use this for dropping off and picking up children.** These guidelines are essential in ensuring the safety of all children.

STUDENT DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

This school year, Kindergarten and Kindergarten siblings will be picked up in the front of the school beginning at 1:55pm. Parents must have a CurbSmart decal with a specified number to pick up students. Cars will pull all the way up and the students will be dismissed to the car.

1st-5th grade students will be picked up at 1:55pm on 36th Street. Parking and/or leaving vehicles will not be permitted in the drop-off/pick-up area during arrival and dismissal. We are asking parents to display their car tag on the rear-view mirror and proceed all the way forward in the car loop line where a PLE staff member will assist students getting into their cars.

If you intend to send your child home as a walker, please specify to your student's teacher whether they will be walking home by themselves or picked up as a walker by a parent. Kindergarteners and their siblings who are walkers being escorted by a parent, will be released at 2:05 and met in the front of school.

Kindergarteners and their siblings who are walking home without a parent escort will be dismissed from the 36th street entrance along with 1st through 5th grade walkers. 1st through 5th grade walkers will be dismissed at 2:05 from the 36th street entrance regardless of whether a parent is meeting them for pick up or they are walking without an adult escort.

STUDENT SIGN-IN AND SIGN-OUT

ONLY parents or persons listed as authorized emergency contacts on a student's contact registration card may sign the student out of school. Photo identification must be presented before a student may be signed out. Please note that due to the large number of student sign-out near the end of the school day, **there is no**

student sign-out after 1:30pm. If there is a change to your child's dismissal, please let the teacher know by 1pm.

On the first day of school, student will be sent home with a "first day packet". Please review this thoroughly. Within the packet, you will see a form to provide emergency contact information. If phone numbers and/or addresses change throughout the school year, please visit our office staff to update your student's information.

RAINY DAY DISMISSAL

Given the unpredictable nature of South Florida's weather, we encourage students to carry a small portable umbrella or raincoat in their backpack. If inclement weather is probable, students are expected to go to their regularly assigned grade level location.

UNIFORMS

School uniforms will be enforced for the 2023-2024 school year. Dress code options are as follows:

Shirts – Solid Navy Blue, Light Blue and White colored shirts with the Eagle logo or no logo polo shirts in the same colors.

Pants – Solid Navy Blue and Khaki bottoms (no cargo, sweat or athletic pants)

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Park Lakes Elementary School places a high value on student learning, academic achievement and the overall success of our students.

Student are required to ALWAYS wear their ID badges. Park Lakes Elementary School will provide the first ID badge and lanyard at no cost.

As part of our safety procedure for the 2023-2024 school year, we will be conducting active shooter, emergency, and evacuation drills in coordination with local police and fire rescue to better prepare in the event of a true emergency.

Maintaining a safe and secure school is our highest priority. We ask for everyone's support; if you **see something, say something!** Everyone is encouraged to report suspicious or dangerous behavior, as well as any threats to our school. 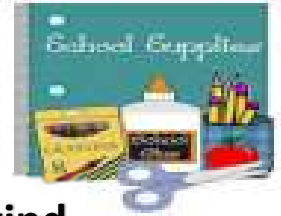
