Dear Parent/Guardian:

The Head Start Performance Standard 1302.42 – Child Health Status and Care, requires the Early Head Start program to maintain up to date records of age-appropriate preventive and primary health care on children enrolled in the program. This requirement includes physicals, immunizations, and dental screenings.

For your convenience, we have summarized the schedule of physicals, immunizations and dental screenings established by the State of Florida Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnosis and Treatment Program (EPSDT), which guides the periodic notices we provide you requesting copy(ies) of your child’s medical records.

Please provide the program with the required health records for your child to have uninterrupted participation in the program.
