Content Area Specialist Reports

Eligibility Recruitment Selection Enrollment and Attendance (ERSEA)

- The cumulative enrollment for Head Start (HS) and Early Head Start (EHS) for August 2022 was 1834 (ERSEA 1305.7).
- During the month of August, summer applications were processed for the 2022-2023 school year.
- Head Start continued to accept eligible children to fill open seats. Eligible families were sent an email with the registration steps and required documents needed for enrollment prior to their child attending school for the 2022-2023 school year.
- General Clerk II staff revisited 400 incomplete applications to obtain missing items and were able to complete the applications.
- Parent Educators and HS staff assisted families with completing HS enrollment forms and school registration.
- The monthly average attendance for August 2022 was 90.97% (ERSEA 1305.8).

Health and Nutrition

- The Head Start Nurse met with school staff for individualized training on health procedures.
- The Health Team created care plans for children with medical needs and allergies.
- Vision, Hearing, and Speech and Language screenings were conducted.
- The Health Team prepared school health, dental, and immunization records.
- Height and weight measurements were completed for Head Start children and nutrition plans were developed.
- Health supplies were sent to the school staff which included first aid kits and travel bags for safety.

Disabilities

- The Inclusion Specialists assisted with first day attendance counts at their assigned HS school sites.
- The Inclusion Specialists reviewed incoming Individual Education Plans (IEPs) with classroom teachers.
- The Inclusion Specialists participated in Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) meetings at school sites.



- The Disabilities team participated in the professional learning session, "DECA FLIP IT".
- The Behavior Specialists developed hands-on materials and resources for children exhibiting challenging behaviors. The resources were delivered to the classroom teacher and modeling of the interventions were conducted.

Mental Health

- The Social Worker Team assisted with first day attendance counts at their assigned HS school sites.
- The Social Worker Team conducted classroom visits to provide Devereux Early Childhood Assessment (DECA) strategies and resources for each teacher.
- The Social Worker Team provided ongoing support to families and children through referrals to community resource agencies as needed.
- The Social Worker Team collaborated with the Teacher Specialists and the Disabilities Team to support children that have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or are on the MTSS schedule.
- The Social Worker Team participated in the "DECA FLIP IT" professional learning session.

Parent Family and Community Engagement (PFCE)

- Parent Educators (PEs) continued to take applications for the 2022-2023 school year at sites: Wingate Oaks Center, Gulfstream Early Learning Center, and E. Pat Larkins Center.
- The Family Service Specialist and Parent Educators continued to provide updated community resources to the families.

Family Services

- PEs continued to attend virtual meetings with their families to provide support as needed.
- PEs continued to assist parents with uploading the required documents into Child Plus to complete their applications.
- PEs continued to respond to emails from their families regarding pending concerns.
- PEs continued to collaborate with the Family Service Specialist to ensure families were supported.
- The Family Service Specialist continued reaching out to outside agencies to provide additional social service support to Head Start families.



Education

- "CLASS Feedback Strategies" professional learning session presented by Teachstone was attended
 by all Teacher Specialists. The session was offered to ensure that Teacher Specialists remain
 consistent and accurate when using the Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS) and
 providing feedback.
- Teacher Specialists participated in the "DECA FLIP IT" professional learning session.
- The new Teacher Specialists completed CLASS training to become CLASS certified.
- Veteran Teacher Specialists provided mentoring and peer coaching to the new Teacher Specialists.
- The Professional Development (PD) Team designed professional learning courses in Canvas for Ouarter 1.
- The PD Team collaborated with the Curriculum Supervisor to identify dates and topics for professional learning sessions.
- Teacher Specialists met with all teachers to collaborate on coaching requirements for the school year.
- Teacher Specialists provided ongoing instructional coaching support to teachers to ensure that all Head Start Education requirements are met by the due dates.
- Teacher Specialists provided teachers with Tier I and Tier II strategies to support student learning and social emotional concerns.
