As part of the SMART Initiative, the School Board of Broward County, Florida (SBBC) and Superintendent Robert W. Runcie committed to allocating \$100,000 towards school choice enhancement (capital-related) projects at each District school. This document provides information about the school choice enhancements process.

School Choice Enhancements Project Selection Options

1. A school can select a project from its School Summary Report that is currently not funded, totaling less than \$100,000. The list of unfunded needs for each school can be found on its School Detail report, located at browardschools.com/Web/Smart-News.

About School Choice Enhancements Projects

School choice enhancement will be allocated to every District school-based, school-choice the condition of an instructor space at the school. 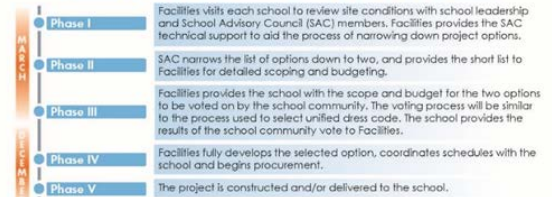

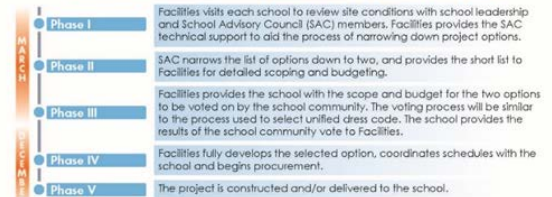
When would the school choice enhancements projects occur?
