- \* Principals, LEA Representatives and at least one Gifted Endorsed Teacher (or teacher on an Out-of-Field waiver) must sign the LEA Agreement.



- \* The bank of EP goals and Objectives has been removed from EASY IEP.
- \* Curriculum goals must address the student's areas of strength (minimum of 2)
- \* May address an area of weakness in the Social/ Emotional and Independent Functioning domains
- \* EP's can be developed for a one-year or two-year period unless there is a social/emotional goal. If there is a goal in this domain the EP must be written for a one-year period.
- \* Goals need to be observable and measureable
- \* EP Writing Workshops will be scheduled in October
- \* A PowerPoint on how to write EP's is located on our website and also on the main

# \*Educational Plans (EP's)

- \* All EP's need to be reviewed for incoming 6<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders
- \* The EP must reflect the services that are currently offered at the middle school or high school that the student will be attending
- \* Any changes to the EP should be done within the first 4 weeks of school



\* Transfer students

- \* In-state
  - \* Gifted students transferring from other districts within the state of Florida are accepted without any further qualifications
  - \* EP's need to be reviewed and transferred to Broward County forms within the first 4 weeks of school
- \* Out-of-state
  - \* When a student who has an EP that was in effect in an out-of-state school district enrolls, the school must provide services comparable to those in the students EP until the new school conducts an initial evaluation or determines that evaluation is not necessary because the student meets the state criteria for gifted eligibility.



\* Endorsement courses are available through BVU

- \* If you are on an out-of-field waiver you must complete two courses per year
- \*Schedule of upcoming courses
