<u>Attendance</u>

- <u>SCHOOL STAFF</u>: Students that cannot attend because the family evacuated from the area and have not been able to return should notify the school and attendance is marked *Excused, Special Event* "AE06".

Homeless Education Assistance Resource Team (HEART)

Homelessness is defined as: residing in shelters, hotels/motels, living in cars, parks, bus/train stations, abandoned buildings and other places not intended for human habitation. Students and families who have lost housing and temporarily reside "**doubled-up**" with friends or family members in an environment that cannot be considered fixed, regular and adequate also qualify for McKinney-Vento services.
