Homeless Education Assistance Resource Team (H.E.A.R.T.)



A Federal law, called McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act, seeks to help eligible families experiencing housing instability.

What is housing instability?

Some examples include living "doubled-up" sharing the housing of friends or family due to a loss of housing or income needed to maintain housing. Other examples include living in a family or youth shelter, living in a motel, car, park or abandoned building due to loss of housing.

What can HEART help eligible families and youth with?

- School supplies and uniform as needed
- Coordination of transportation to school of origin (certain rules apply)
- Referrals to school and community-based services including (but not limited to) tutoring, family counseling, school Social Worker, medical/dental, mental health services, limited after school care and summer camp opportunities, and housing.
- Retrieval of immunization records and State of Florida birth certificates
- Free school meals
- Graduating Seniors receive verification letters for the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), post-secondary tuition and fee waiver consideration, and their graduation cap and gown rental at no cost.

Broward County Public Schools Counseling and BRACE Advisement department will host the following community workshops for students and parents.


