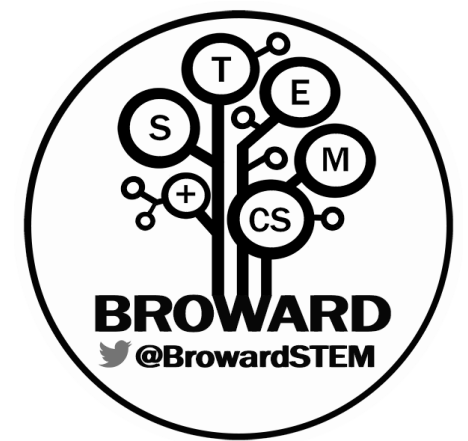
U.S. Dept. of Education Green Ribbon Schools

3. provide effective environmental and sustainability education

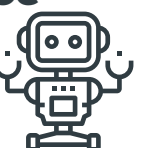

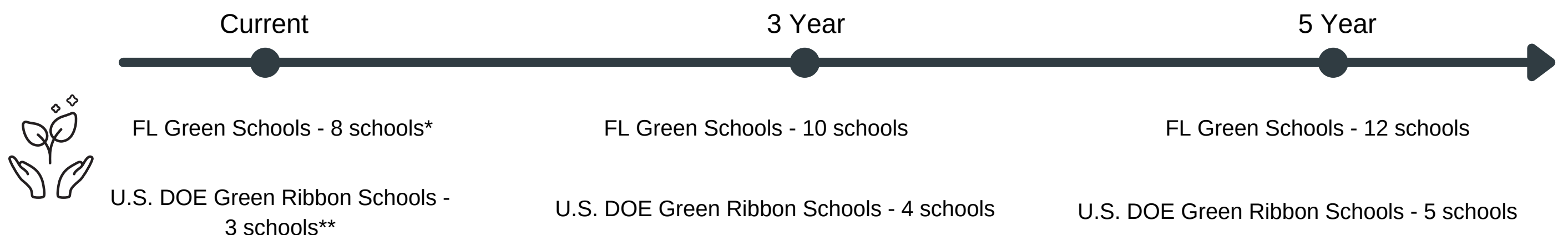
