Purpose

The Before and After School Child Care (BASCC) Master Plan defines quality outcomes and measures fidelity. The method of implementation in reaching those outcomes is acquired through unannounced quality needs evaluation visits.

The BASCC Master Plan:

- Clarifies expectations about the role and responsibility of a specific position or job
- Educates participants upon the expectations of the services they are required to provide
- Provides data for the standards on the BASCC Quality Standards Needs Assessment Tool. and Program Safety Visits
- Provides guidance for self-assessment
- Identifies concrete actions for individuals
- Supports the development of short-term and long-term benchmarks
- Provides a basis for professional learning and development in the areas of professionalism, indoor activities, safety, creative arts/drama, special needs students, academic games, behaviors, and outdoor activities
- Classifies program performance of critical components within the BASCC Quality Standards Needs Assessment Tool.

Needs Assessment

Personnel complete pre and post tests before and after participating in professional learning activities. The goal of the workshop series is for participants to develop a complete understanding of the material that is covered. This is measured by comparing the pre-test to the post test. The goals are for participants to improve their score and to acquire a minimum of 80% on the post test. Pre and post tests are administered through Microsoft Forms.
