#### **Polar Express Day**



Our morning arrival car rider line procedures are changing due to some safety concerns. Starting Tuesday, November 12th, you will notice that the car line has been separated by a row of cones from the parking spaces. Once you enter the car line, we are asking that everyone cooperate with the following:

- Pull all the way forward. Once your car stops, please have your child exit from the right side of your car only.
- Please do not get out of your car for any reason.
- You will need to stay in the car line all the way until the end of the lane to exit.
- PreK parents will no longer leave their cars to bring their children to Gate #2. The Pre-K assistants will be coming to the car lane to escort the students to the gate.
- If a PreK parent needs to park, then they need to pull into one of the designated PreK parent spots.
