Was not born in the U.S.A. and whose native language is a language other than English

OR

Comes from home environment where a language other than English is spoken

OR

Is American Indian or Alaskan native, who comes from an environment where a language other than English has had a significant impact on his or her level of English language

AND

Has sufficient difficulty speaking, reading, writing, or listening to the English language.

How does a student enter the ESOL Program?

When you register at the school, if the answer is “Yes” to any of the 3 Home Language Survey questions...

Step 1

The school assesses the student’s proficiency level of English with a Listening & Speaking screener.



Step 2

Based on results, a student may be identified as an ELL...

Step 3

What happens after a student is identified as an ELL?

The student is assigned a language classification based on IPT test results

The student is assigned instructional accommodations

School sends notification letter to parent

Teachers are informed and ESOL instructional strategies and accommodations are implemented

Student performance is monitored on a regular basis

English for Speakers of Other Languages (ESOL) Program

Develop competency in English for social interaction and academic English in order to successfully participate in the formal curriculum.








What is Canvas?

Canvas is a learning management system, or LMS, and is often described as, "a way to simplify teaching and learning by connecting all the digital tools teachers and students use in one easy place".



Students can access Canvas through their [single-sign-on clever launch pad](#), but teachers need to publish courses and content before students can participate and interact with them.



Accessing the Canvas Parent App








Step 1. How does your child get to school?

Step 1 – go to <https://sso.browardschools.com>



Students need to go to sso.browardschools.com to access their Clever Single-Sign-On Launchpad


Step 2 – Select the Login with Active Directory, a popup box will appear (**make sure you have the pop-up blocker turned off**). Enter your child's username and password and hit OK.



Have your child sign in with his/her student number and password/PIN to get to his/her personalized Clever Single Sign-On Launchpad.

Step 2. How does your child enter school?



Each student's dashboard is different depending on grade level.

Here is a sample of one.

For young and complex learners, parents/guardians should log in with the student information.


Step 3. How does your child get to class?




If your child has multiple courses (middle and high school), they need to review their school schedule to know the order in which they should be attending classes.

Have your child go to Virtual Counselor to find out his/her class schedule.

Virtual Counselor may be accessed by logging onto your child's Single Sign-On LaunchPad at sso.browardschools.com and clicking on the Virtual Counselor file.



Step 4. How does your child enter class?



Have your child click on the Canvas image outlined on their SSO Launch Pad.



That will take your child to their Canvas course(s). Each course is a tile, so a student with multiple courses will have multiple tiles.

Use the “Courses” button on the left blue navigation bar to access your courses. Or you can click on the Canvas Tile to bring you into your Canvas course.

Step 5. How does your child find his/her Canvas schoolwork and Teams web conference link?



Read any of the teacher's announcements at the top of the home page of the Canvas course and then look for assignments below. If the teacher has designed work in Modules, click on the Modules link on the left side of the course navigation to begin seeing the units of study.

Teachers will be providing live web conferencing through Microsoft Teams. The link to these live meetings will be placed in a Canvas Home Page.

Attendance is required every day in class. To be counted present in class you must attend the TEAMS webinar at the beginning of each class period, just like you would have attended class if we were face-to-face. Since I have more than one section of pre-calculus you will have to click on the correct link for your period each day. - **To the Teams web conference by using the Join Link provided by their teacher to receive daily instruction**




While your child engages in e-Learning they may not be on the computer all day.

English Language Learners receive accommodations during **statewide assessments AND daily instruction**





2. Establish routines and expectations. Set a daily schedule and follow it.


