

AP Gov

AP United States Government & Politics provides a college level, nonpartisan introduction that characterizes the constitutional and the political culture of the United States. The course features five BIG ideas that pertain to American government. Such as Constitutionalism, Liberty and Order, Civic Participation, Competing Policymaking Interests and Methods of Political Analysis. Students will be expected to be well-versed in 8 foundational documents and 15 landmark Supreme Court cases. The course focuses on:

- analyzing arguments from past and present political leaders
- relating concepts to political institutions in America
- developing and strengthening reasoning processes
- Legislative and policymaking processes



AP Macro

AP MACROECONOMICS is a college level course designed to study Economics on a global perspective. The four BIG ideas such as scarcity, choice, economic behaviors and market efficiency.

The course requires students to define economic principles, explain economic outcomes, determine the outcomes of specific economic situations and model economic situations using graphs or visual representations.

This is a one Semester course and requires students to work diligently and attend class regularly. Basic Algebraic skills are required.

Both AP courses are offered as Semester long courses. Students are required to register for BOTH AP courses . Both AP courses will satisfy the graduation requirement: 1/2 credit of government and a 1/2 credit of Economics


NO Prerequisite is required. Students in BOTH AP U.S. Government & Politics and AP Macroeconomics should have strong reading, writing and analytical skills

Benefits of AP

College credit is awarded if the student passes the AP exam with a 3 or higher.

AP courses stand out in the college admission process because they demonstrate academic rigor.

AP Scholar Granted to students who receive scores of 3 or higher on three or more AP Exams.

AP Seminar and Research Certificate is granted to students who earn scores of 3 or higher in both AP Seminar and AP Research.

AP Capstone Diploma is awarded to student who earn scores of 3 or higher in AP Seminar and AP research and four additional AP exams of their choosing.

AP Offers additional quality points in the weighted GPA

Passing score on AP US History or AP Government exam may be used to meet the new Civics graduation requirement.
