- ☐ **Register for Broward College as a Dual Enrollment Student**
 - a. See instructions included with this checklist

- ☐ **Schedule the PERT In Person/On Campus at MCA**
 - a. Available to all MCA students anytime during the week
 - b. Available to Charter/Private School students on Wednesdays
 - c. Call the High School Office to schedule – 754.322.3905
 - d. FREE to students

- ☐ **Schedule the Accuplacer at Broward.edu – Remote or In Person/On Campus** (Accuplacer NEXT GENERATION; select Common Placement Tests – Reading, Writing, & Math are required)
 - a. First attempt: *On Campus Testing* **FREE**; *Remote Testing* **\$11.50**
 - b. Additional Attempts: *On Campus Testing* **\$33.50**; *Remote Testing* **\$43.50**
 - c. Retain copy of scores to upload to application portal

- ☐ **Provide middle school transcripts – 6th, 7th, 8th grades; Standardized test Scores**
 - a. Provide for any year student did not attend a BCPS school; Required for any school years at a private or charter school or out of district/state/country
 - b. Upload to application portal

- ☐ **Complete your School Choice application** (required for ALL applicants, even current MCA students)
 - a. Visit www.browardschools.com/schoolchoice - Apply as REASSIGNMENT
 - b. Phase 2 window opens **May 1st**

Choose PERT or Accuplacer; you do not need to take both.

→Applicants will receive instructions to submit documents after the School Choice application is completed←

NOTE: Notification of acceptance will be sent after the School Choice window closes

Minimum Requirements*:

- At least a 3.0 High School GPA
- Pass Accuplacer** (Writing: 253 Reading: 256 Math: 261); Or
- Pass PERT (Writing: 103 Reading: 106 Math: 114)
- Excellent academic standing (middle school grades and standardized exams)
