## Cambridge AICE Diploma Curriculum

The Cambridge AICE Diploma coursework is composed of engaging and rigorous Cambridge International AS \& A Level classes spanning diverse subject groups. To achieve the AICE Diploma, all learners must pass the examinations for a minimum of seven courses in designated subject areas, within a 25 -month period, which begins with their first exam series. Course requirements include the compulsory Cambridge International AS Level Global Perspectives \& Research course and at least one course each from groups 1, 2, and 3. The remaining credits can be selected from any of the four subject groups.
