3. Quorum was established by (Chair) Carolyn Smith
4. Mid-Year Data and Learning Gains Presentation by Coach Rowe and Coach Smith:
 - a. ELA Data – Coach Smith
 - i. Currently 31% proficient overall
 - ii. 11th grade retakes rendered that they are 66% proficient
 - iii. 12th grade retakes rendered that they are 87% proficient
 - b. Math Data- Coach Rowe
 - i. Currently CFA 2 shows that Algebra is at 38% proficient
 - ii. Currently CFA 2 shows that Geometry is at 34.4% proficient
 - iii. There are currently 46 seniors missing their math test requirement
 - c. Learning Gains PD- Coach Rowe and Coach Smith
 - i. The different buckets were discussed and how students can or cannot be eligible depending on testing
 - ii. If a student did not test last year, they cannot count for learning gains, but can count for proficiency
 - iii. Discussed how students in the lowest quartile can account for multiple buckets
 - iv. Talked about ELP plans and how we the team is tackling lowest quartile gains as well as graduation rate during Study Hall
