<p>Violation #56. Ventilation & lighting Ventilation exhaust air ducts are dirty in walk-in fridge. Clean ventilation exhaust air ducts.</p> <p>Observed light in disrepair, not working properly in dry storage. Replace light.</p> <p>CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(6)(a). Adequate exhaust ventilation hood systems in food prep and warewashing areas shall be provided and designed. 50 foot candles shall be at surfaces where employees work with food and 20 foot candles shall be at surfaces where food is provided to consumers.</p>
