- a. SESIR data
 - Through February 29,2024; 48 SESIR events have been reported.
- b. Budget
 - The Title 1 budget for the next school year has already been submitted. However, the school budget for next year has not been submitted yet.
 - We have \$19,700. 57 in Accountability Funds and \$5878.00 in School Recognition Funds. We still have just under \$8000 left to spend on instructional material. We still have CAPE funds of \$15,981. The money can only be used for CAPE classes. Additionally, we have Digital Tools funds of \$25,000.



- o Title I funds will pay for IXL for Math
- Civics will continue to utilize *Study Island* which is paid for from Title I budget as well.
- 98% of course requests for the upcoming school year are in the system already. There is a deadline of April 4, 2024.
