### <u>Minutes</u>

### 1. Welcome Mrs. Perez Mrs. Perez welcomed everyone to our SAC meeting, and Ms. Suarez motioned for the meeting to start at 5:07 pm.

#### 2. Approval of SAC Meeting Minutes Mrs. Perez The minutes were read, and approval moved by Mr. Pigan.

## 3. New Business for SAC

- The date for the March SAC meeting was moved forward from Wednesday, March 20, 2024, to Tuesday, March 19, 2024.
- SIP: For this month we had a department presentation-Ms. Comple (Writing Coach) presented data for the ELA department. For ELA, one of the targets is to increase gains for the students who achieved in the lowest 30% band. Teachers are currently reviewing Common Formative Assessments (CFAs) and remediating the lowest standards. Write Score is a new tool that the ELA teachers use for help in scoring the essays written by students.
- Middle school students are taking the FAST-Writing exam for the first time in April of 2024.
- There are new cut scores for the FAST state exam.

## 4. Principal Updates

Dr. Kushner

- Dr. Timmons was promoted to Assistant Principal at an elementary school and Ms. Perez was promoted to Magnet Coordinator.
- Two new teachers were hired.

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There have been 11 incidents so far this school year. Dr. Kushner appealed to the parents to be vigilant with regards to the vaping situation.

- Broward Schools District will come in and visit classrooms at Apollo tomorrow, October 26, 2023.
- Broward Schools District is moving to a new platform for all things scheduling. Focus is the name of the platform.
- There will be a Magnet Showcase here at Apollo on November 17, 2023.
- Magnet applications for high school for the upcoming school year opens on December 1, 2023.
- Facilities update: the roof, painting, and media center are complete. We are still waiting on A/C units so the next phase of our renovation project will tentatively begin in early December 2023.
- We have \$24, 000 left from the SMART bond money. It is intended that it will be used to upgrade room 111 into a STEM lab.
- We still have \$5,870 from past monies and the current balance from last year is \$23,768.44.
- Dr. Kushner is requesting \$18, 388 to put additional wall wraps, and to purchase new rubber mats increased. A vote was taken-13 attendees voted yes. The request was thus approved.
- We have money from STEM related donations/grants. Dr. Kushner will let SAC know the exact amount that we have as soon as he gets the number.

- We will have our literacy parent engagement night and Book Fair tonight starting at 6 pm . Everyone is invited.
