- 2. Approve February's Minutes (needs quorum) Mrs. Jones motioned to approve, Mrs. Perry seconded the motion.
- 3. Principal's Update/Reports: Ribbon celebration was held in February. To celebrate the opening of our Art and Music room. Kindergarten has a new garden funded by families and PTO. Kindergarten round-up night was held last week. We will continue to hold school tours throughout the month of March. Teacher intentions for following school year were submitted. Extended Learning Camps will take place after Spring break.
