Standardized Tests

Colleges use tests like the SAT and the ACT for:

- Admission to compare you to other candidates in their application pool
- Placement to choose the most appropriate courses for you
- Scholarship Opportunities

Colleges Entrance Exams Are Based On Content Knowledge, <u>Therefore</u>:

- The more knowledge you acquire your high school years, the better your test scores will be.
- Students who are taking the test to pass the FCAT, in a reading class, or are taking Algebra 2 are encouraged to register for the **May** & **June** Test Dates



SAT Waivers Have 12 Number Digits.



S7: Upload Photo

Photo Upload Requirements

Enhanced identification and security requirements are in place for this test date. You will be prompted to upload a recent photo that meets the requirements listed below. The photo will print on your ticket and on the score report we send to your high school. You can't print your ticket until the photo is added—and without a ticket, you can't test. If you don't add your photo by the <a href="https://pubm.nih.gov/photo-phot

ACT Photo Requirements

- Your photo must be a clear image of you—and only you—against a plain background.
- · You must be facing the camera.
- · You cannot wear dark glasses.
- · You can upload a JPG, JPEG, PNG, or BMP image file.
- Maximum file size is 5 MB.
- · Minimum photo size if you scan your file is passport size (2 x 2 inches or larger).
- · Photo must be at least 640 x 480 pixels.
- If you have scanned your photo, crop the image to remove any extra background or white space before you upload it.
- . If you wear a head covering daily for religious reasons, adjust it to provide a full-face view.






S8: Select Your Test Date

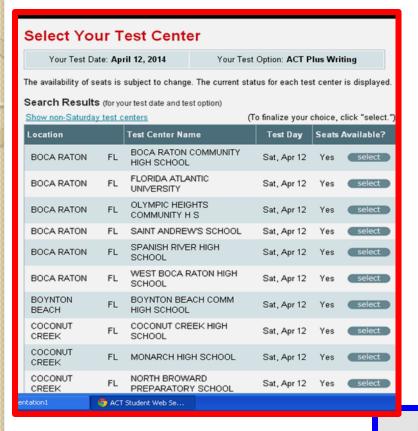

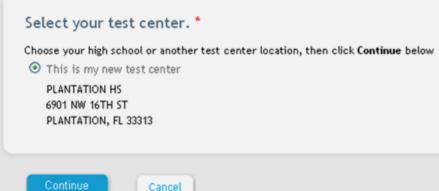
S9: Select Your Test Location

You can also take it at a different location if it is more convenient.

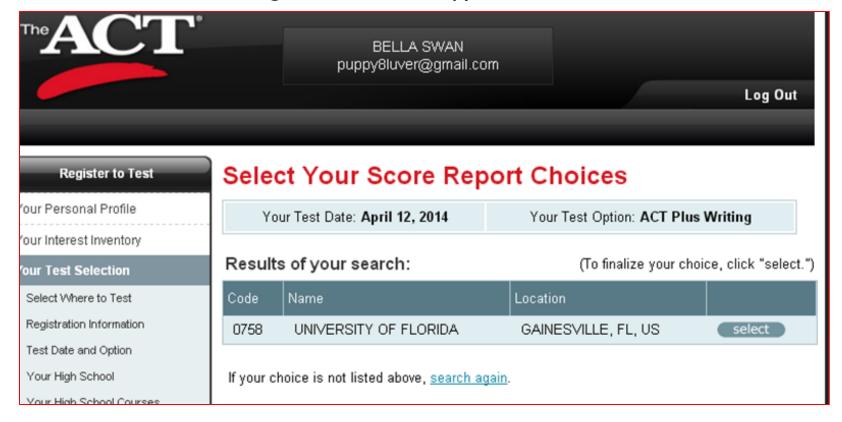
The SAT is NOT administered at Piper High School.
You must take it at another location. Plantation HS and Taravella HS are popular choices for our students.



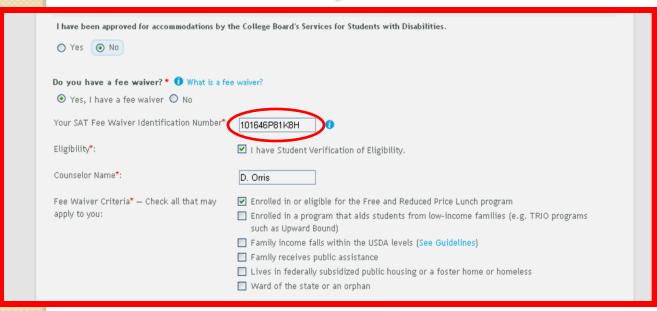
SIO: Score Reports

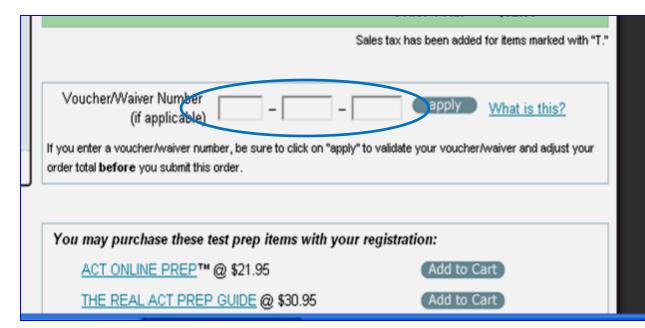


SII: Payment With A Waiver

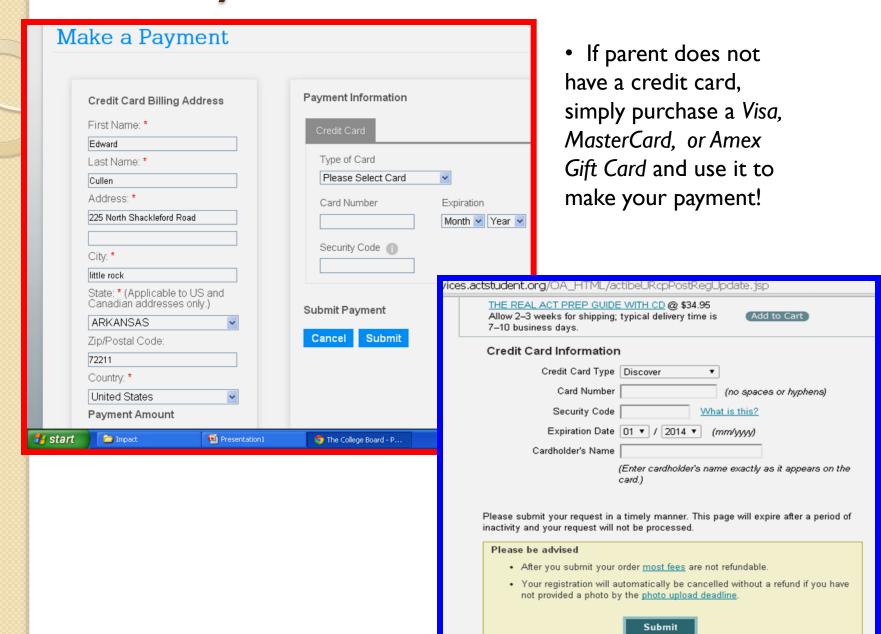

S12: Print Your Admissions Ticket

Students can print their SAT Admission Ticket whether they registered online or by paper.

To print a ticket or make corrections online, a student should:

- Sign in to My SAT. If the student hasn't already created a collegeboard.org username and password, he or she should do so now.
- Click "Print Admission Ticket."
- Update the ticket's information as necessary. Changes to test type, test date or test center are subject to a <u>change fee</u>.
- Print the Admission Ticket.

Students MUST print your ticket from their **ACT** Web account when prompted, after your registration or standby request is confirmed. You will **NOT** receive a ticket in the mail.

If you registered by mail:

If you do not receive a ticket in the mail by 10 days before the test date, log in to your ACT Web account to print it or call 319.337.1270 immediately.

It is important to Remember:

General Information

- You must print out the ticket, and bring it and a picture ID with you the day of the test.
 - You will not be admitted without the Test Ticket and Valid ID!
- Prepare a bag with everything you need (#2 pencils, approved calculator, ticket, picture ID, and snacks) the night before.
- Get a good night sleep and have a good breakfast ©
- Be on time- you will not be admitted if you are late.

For those on Free and Reduced Lunch

- Please see Mrs. Orris in Room 135/Bldg A to Receive Waivers
- You can <u>never</u> register late and pay with a test fee waiver
- You only get two ACT and two SAT test waivers for your whole life.
 - You may also receive only two SAT Subject Test Waivers.
- After you take the ACT/SAT test and have paid with a waiver, you become eligible to receive College Application Waivers your Senior year!
 - Proof of completed application must be shown prior to receiving one
 - Please note that some colleges do not accept application fee waivers
