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Minutes

⚡ Call to Order -meeting called to order at 4:30pm by Ms. Clark School Advisory Chair. A quorum was present 10/14.

⚡ Review and approve minutes from November 19, 2024. – Stakeholders read minutes quietly to themselves. Ms. Clark gave highlights on a few areas. Minutes approved as is by all stakeholders.

⚡ Reports:

- Academic and Instructional Data Updates-MS. Hamilton provide updates on math and ELA compared to PM1 and PM2 for 2024 versus 2025. ELA is up from last year 2024 (25% proficiency) as compared to 2025 (28%). Students still have not learned all the standards. Our WIG goal is 52%. Goal is to get off the RAISE list on the state platform. To do this teacher must group students and get students the support they need. All subgroups matter. I-Ready increased across all graded levels for ELA and math. Math scores decreased on FAST across all grade levels for PM1 to PM2, except 4th grade increased by 10%.
- Title I-68% compliance for ebinder. The website is out of compliance.
- Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) data-none
- Principal's Report by Mrs. Lizano
 - Color Run rescheduled for Tuesday January 28, 2025, due to poor weather conditions predicted on Jan 22, 2025. If students raise \$20, they get to silly string ADMIN on Jan 31, 2025, this is a separate event from color run.

- Kids Heart Challenge is February 14, 2025. Commonly known as Jump Rope for Hearts.
- Literacy Week next week Mrs. Lizano sent down dress days via parent link.
- Reminders: Late students are an ongoing concern especially as we get closer to testing. Tentative test dates will be sent home to parents and tips for successful testing like get a good night sleep and eat a good breakfast.
- District showcase for Broward schools. Schools shared their respective programs with the Community. This event will happen to attract parents back to Broward Schools.


Old Business

- Update on A+ plus funds have been approved by district. We are waiting on guidance from the payroll/budget department to provide formula to calculate pro-rated faculty/staff.

New Business

- Media Collection Development Plan-presented by Ms. Hoisington-overview of books that are in the Media Center. From this report Ms. Hoisington will order more history books, easier readers, and general fiction books.
- Accountability Funds for School Marketing-Mrs. Lizano 2024-25 (\$4809.29) -Mrs. Lizano wants to us \$2200 (rough estimate) for school beautification and marketing. She wants to purchase portable sign with school name/logo and 2 school feather flags. Motion made by Ms. Lee to use accountability funds rough estimate of \$2,200 for portable billboard for school marketing and 2 feather flags for school beautification. Motioned 2nd by Mrs. Sirmanne. The SAC stakeholders voted in favor of accountability funds estimated at \$2200 for school marketing and school beautification.
