Working hard and learning how to become great readers. Please take some time every day to read with them at home and practice sight words daily too. Ask them about what they're reading and talk to them about the parts of a book. Challenge them to write a sentence or two about the story they read! In math, we are working on addition and we will be learning about sound in science. We will be having field day on December 13th from 8:30-10:30. Please contact your child's teacher if you would like to volunteer. More information will be sent home about that fun day! We will be learning about holidays around the world and doing many fun holiday activities in our classrooms. Please make sure to keep reading with your child over the holiday break. First Grade

The month of November went by quickly! We spent time discussing family traditions and talking about the things we are truly thankful for. We also took some time to look at how the life in the past is so different from the life now in the present time. Ask your child to share some of the differences and similarities they learned about the past and present. In math, we are finishing the Topics on addition and subtraction strategies. Remember, practicing math facts helps build math fluency. Coming up with math games together as a family can help with fluency too! After this topic, we will be learning about interpreting data and extending the counting sequence! Please encourage your child to practice nightly. December will be full of learning and celebrating the holidays! Please continue to support your child's academic progress by reading, practicing sight words, and learning

Hope everyone had a wonderful Thanksgiving! As we return from our Fall Break, the mid-year I-Ready Diagnostic Window will begin and we will be completing these before Winter Break. This is another short month and attendance is very important for students. In Reading, we will continue to spiral previous standards. We will be continuing Unit 4 and working on plot structure and main story elements, different characters' perspectives, and theme. In Math, we have continued to master our math fluency with addition and subtraction. We will also be continuing double-digit subtraction strategies. As well as solving word problems and knowing what the question is asking. We will always be spiraling previous objectives already covered throughout the rest of the year. In Science, we are wrapping up Push and Pull. Next, we will be exploring Magnets and Gravity, then Force and Motion. In Social Studies we have been learning about Native American Heritage and student's "at home projects" will be due the beginning of the month. We are so excited to see and share these in class! The Holiday Shop will be running during the week of December 9th. Please keep an eye out for information from your teacher to see what day your child will be going. Field Day will be on Monday, December 16th at 11:30 for 2nd grade. Don't forget to wear your class shirt this day. On December 18th Parkside will have our annual "Polar Express Day", which is always a day filled with excitement! When we return in January, students will be taking the PM2 Star Assessments for Reading and Math. We wish everyone a wonderful holiday and Happy New Year!

November!? Seriously? Wasn't it summer, just a few weeks ago? Third Grade Time flies when we're working hard I guess! Third grade students are currently working more on Division and Multiplication and will soon be working on parts of Geometry like Area and Perimeter. Students will benefit greatly from a few minutes of daily facts practice with flashcards and/or making lists. If they at least know their facts for 1, 2, 3, 5 and 10, the rest are easier to figure out. In ELA, we are going to be concentrating on quotations, expository writing, cause and effect, compare and contrast, text features, and fluency. We are settling into our Walk-to Read routines. In Science, we are continuing our journey into the forms of Energy and how they relate to each other. In Social Studies, we continue to learn about regions and countries of North America, as well as our national landmarks. We will also touch on the election process and the three levels of government. We have been delayed in booking our field trips, due to certain date availability. We expect to have a definitive schedule for some great field trips very soon. Coming up, we look forward to seeing everyone that will be coming to the Thanksgiving Luncheon on November 22. Don't forget that every Thursday is "THIRDSDAY!" Students are encouraged to wear their class shirts on this day each week. Happy Thanksgiving! Gobble Gobble!

Fourth Grade October came and went! It was a busy month filled with lots of fun activities, especially the week of red ribbon. In preparations for science night, 4th grade has gone through five different experiments. Each class will be creating five different science boards to present at science night. Kids have really enjoyed going through the scientific process. Moreover, in the area of math we have worked on two digit by two digit multiplication and now we are in division. In language arts, we have worked on singular and plural nouns. In reading, our focus has been on point of view and perspective. In social studies, our focus has been on the geography of Florida. The window for our annual Saint Augustine field trip has also recently opened. The holidays are right around the corner, so we're preparing for a busy and fun November.

Fifth Grade

We cannot believe that we are already heading into December! There will be many fun events going on such as Field Day, Polar Express Day and the PTA Holiday Shop. Also, information has come home regarding the 5th end of year field trip. The deposit is \$173.00, and we will be able to determine the remaining balance once all deposits come in. <u>Kindergarten</u>- FAST Reading on December 16, 2024 and FAST Math on December 17, 2024 <u>1st grade & 2nd grade</u>- FAST Reading on January 8, 2025 and FAST Math on January 16, 2025 <u>3rd grade</u>- FAST Reading on January 14, 2025 and FAST Math on January 22, 2025. <u>4th grade and 5th grade</u>- FAST Math on January 9, 2025 and FAST Reading on January 15, 2025.

*Make-ups for all grade levels are through January 24, 2025. Be sure to check with your child's teacher for any potential date changes as December 2024 gets underway. For more information on the test design, please visit
