Principal's Report</p> <p>Parent University will be taking place the following day November 30, 2022 in the cafeteria to inform parents of new curriculum and standards for Math and Reading. Also, the new FAST and STAR testing.</p> <p>Attendance- importance of attending each day, and on time was discussed. Instruction is provided promptly at 8 A.M. and instruction goes from bell to bell.</p> <p>Small group instruction- Small group intervention is being provided for high needs students by Ms. Norcutt, Ms. Fernander, Ms. Gomez, and Ms. Dorvil. 30 students have i-Ready to help with intervention and Success Maker is provided to each student to provide extra practice.</p>



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	<p>ELO Camp- began November 29, 2022. Extended Learning Opportunity will target specific standards. ELO will be offered based on targeted needs and each round will focus on a specific skill. Students will be targeted based on deficits identified in assessments.</p> <p>Saturday Camp- Offered by the district to only specific grade levels. Information was communicated directly to parents from the district.</p> <p>Vacancies- 684 students total.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Will request a new 1st and 2nd grade class.- New 3rd grade teacher will be Ms. Blanc- 5th grade teacher resigned, Ms. Green will be subbing in until a new permanent teacher can be found.- Need a new Pre-K ESE teacher, as well as a new teacher for the InD (Intellectually Disabled) class.- Had 4 Teacher Assistant Vacancies, we have recommended 2 to be hired. Still need 2 Teacher Assistants.- Plan to address openings: Interview event at the KCW building. <p>Board Member Visit- Lori Alhadeff (School Board Chair)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Cameras will be updated, more cameras will be installed. Cables have been being installed. New cameras will cover blind spots. <p>Make up Days- 2 Hurricane days will be mad up, January 12th and April 20th will become full days instead of Early Release Days.</p> <p>Accountability Funds- Earned through the State and the SAC gets to vote on how the money is spent. Currently have \$16,184.99.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">-Need Quorum to vote on how to spend the money. <p>Winter Shows-</p> <p>Pre-K Show is on December 16th, at 8:30 AM</p> <p>K-2nd Show is on December 22nd at 8:30 AM</p> <p>3rd-5th Shows is on December 23rd, at 8:30 AM</p>
	<p><u>6. School Improvement Plan</u></p> <p>-The School and Improvement Plan was presented by the principal, Ms. Valme. Ms. Walker, Title I Liaison, presented Title I addendum to review with parents and to receive feedback. No feedback by parents and committee was provided after review.</p>
	<p><u>7. Title I Updates- Ms. Jasmine Walker</u></p> <p>-Parent and Family Engagement survey flyers were distributed to students and parent links will be sent weekly to remind parents to complete.</p>



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	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Parents can complete online.-Parent University is taking place on November 30th, 2022.
	<p>8. <u>School-Wide Positive Behavior Plan- Mr. Vinson Jones</u></p> <p>The seriousness of verbal threats- ALL threats must be assessed for seriousness of the threat.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Threat is defined as a declarative statement of punishment or loss to another or to the school.- Threat Assessment Team (includes Mr. Jones (Assistant Principal), Ms. Justice (Guidance Counselor), Ms. DeVera (ESE Specialist), and Deputy Silva (The School Resource Officer).- Team determines the severity of the threat and must call in the parent to inquire about conditions in the home. Students who make threats are followed up on. Student will also be given an SRA (Suicide Risk Assessment).- Plan to address rise in threats:<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Communicate with parents about speaking with their children on making “jokes” and negative, violent language- Discipline Assembly forthcoming: take place 3 times per year. Next one is in January.
