- Principal Report
 - Middle of year FAST Testing has been completed. This data is important and shows projections for the end of year test scores which are used as promotion criteria.
 - The data shows 52% proficiency at the mid-year mark for reading which is ahead of last years mid-year score
 - We are working to close the achievement gap, the goal is for each student to make one years worth of learning gains

- At this time we are showing 48% proficiency in math for the mid-year FAST Test. This is an improvement from the 2023-2024 PM2 FAST Test where we were at 32% proficiency.
- We are working closely to help students better enhance their computer skills to make computer based testing easier for them. The goal is for students to understand how to use computer tools such as highlighting, notetaking, and strikethroughs as they navigate the testing platform.
- ELO Camp has begun, there are about ten teachers participating in the tutoring program.
- Vibrant church is no longer leasing the school building on weekends
