- 1. The student performance report for PM3 has shown great growth. There is a projected increase from 52% to 65% by the 26-27 school year and regarding Grade 9 proficiency it is projected to be from 53% to 63%.
- 2. The district has been showing improvement in scores over the past few years. The south region has been leading with test scores. There is a gap that has been showing in ELA regarding race and ethnicity.
- 3. Graduation rates in BCPS are higher than students in charter schools.
- 4. School Choice Window is from April 7-August.
- 5. Methods of communication regarding the school board is through various meetings, data, and surveys.
