Dress Code - School Board Policy 5309

Coral Cove Academy of the Arts follows the Student Dress Code policy as stated in the Student's Code of Conduct for Broward County Public Schools. Appropriate dress and grooming can help to create a positive learning environment. Other attire may be allowed for special school activities with approval of the school administration. Possible consequences for violating the dress code are found in the Discipline Matrix. Changes in clothing trends will not override the dress code policy. All students are expected to honor their responsibilities and dress in a way that respects the rights of others.

• Unified Dress: A pre-determined color and/or style of clothing for both tops and bottoms that will be worn by all students at the designated school.

FRIDAYS (All Students):

Students are allowed to wear their spirit t-shirt with Khaki uniform slacks or shorts.

NO LEGGINGS or JEANS

- Hooded sweaters or jackets must be worn, with hoods down at all times.
- Clothing that exposes the upper thigh is not allowed. Shorts that are not shorter than mid-thigh, including walking shorts, or Bermuda shorts, are allowed.
- Footwear must be worn at all times. For grades K-12, bedroom slippers are not allowed, backless footwear is not allowed. Additionally, students may not wear backless slingbacks, or open-toed footwear. Socks may not be worn with backless shoes as a substitute back for backless shoes. Parents should ensure that the footwear their students wear to school does not impede their safety.
