### *Grade 9 Registration/Course Selection Instructions*

1. **Use this course card to choose 8 courses.**
  - a. You will have: Study Hall, English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and three electives.
2. Review the Course Card, discuss options with your teachers and parents, and carefully consider which courses will help you be most successful next year.
3. Have teachers initial recommendations on the course cards.
4. If you would like to satisfy the Physical Education graduation requirement during your 9<sup>th</sup> grade year, this can be accomplished by:
  - a. Option 1: 1.0 Credit Physical Education to include integration of health (HOPE)
  - b. Option 2: Complete 2 full seasons of a Junior Varsity or Varsity Sport
  - c. Option 3: Complete 2 full years of JROTC
  - d. Option 4: 0.5 Credit Personal Fitness; and 0.5 Credit PE Elective (may be satisfied thru Marching Band)
5. **You must select 3 Alternate Courses**
6. You will meet with a PHS counselor at your school to review and approve your schedule.
