Eco Patrol is an afterschool club where fourth and fifth grade students can learn about the environment that they live in, connect to their environment, and share their knowledge and experiences with their family and community. We will take a local, as well as global, approach to water conservation, energy use and sources, pollution, natural habitats and wildlife. Our club manages the school-wide recycling program. The fourth and fifth grade students collect the recycling on a weekly basis and work in conjunction with custodial staff who then take the wheeled-blue bins out to the Griffin recycling dumpster.

Since we limit the club members to fourth and fifth grade, we can take **most** students who are interested in participating. Each student must possess self-control, respect for each other, and good manners, since we will be hosting several guest speakers throughout the year.

Meetings will be held once a month on Wednesdays from 2:00pm - 3:00pm. Parents will be responsible for picking up their children and Griffin aftercare students will be released to the aftercare program. Meeting reminders will be posted in your child's classroom and announced on morning announcements.
