# Important Arrival and Dismissal Reminders

**School Times: 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.** First Bell - 7:50 a.m.

Students are not permitted on campus before 7:30 a.m. There is no supervision before 7:30 a.m.

This is an important safety alert for our parents. Please remember that students should not be dropped off or arrive at school prior to 7:30 a.m. This is a safety concern as there is no supervision prior to 7:30 a.m. Please do not stop and drop off or pick up your children on 172<sup>nd</sup> Avenue or 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Also, please do not block the crosswalks while waiting in the car line. Dropping off or picking up your child while stopped on 172<sup>nd</sup> Avenue or 9<sup>th</sup> Street is extremely dangerous for the children, parents and other drivers. Please follow all traffic laws and drive to the appropriate area of the school parking lot to drop off or pick up your children. All CAR RIDERS should be dropped off for school and picked up in the EAST (back of school) parking lot. The WEST Parking lot (front of school) is for District school buses, private transportation vehicles, staff members and A-Team student drop off only.

When dropping off or picking up in the car line, please pull all the way forward until all cars stop before you allow your child to exit or enter the vehicle. Once all cars have stopped, students may exit or enter the vehicle under the covered walkway. Also, students walking / biking to school should always follow the sidewalks around the perimeter of the car line. They are NOT to cut through the car line. This is for everyone's safety. Remember, we are all role models for the children and they learn the rules of the road from us. Thank you for your cooperation in keeping everyone at Panther Run Elementary School Safe.

It is every parents' responsibility to ensure that their child arrives at school on time every day. The first bell rings at 7:50 a.m. Students enter classrooms at 7:50 a.m. to prepare for class. Classes start at 8:00 a.m. Your child will be marked tardy after the second bell and it will be reflected on their report card.

## Panther Run Elementary New Arrival & Dismissal Procedures 2023-2024



Everyone will be held and dismissed from inside the building for the 2023-2024 school year.

Car Line Dismissal Procedures: All car rider students will remain inside the building for car line dismissal (rain or shine). Parents will enter the Eastside of campus via NW 9th Street and drive through the back car loop. The school issued car rider placard with your child's name and grade level must be displayed in the front window of your vehicle. A staff member at the front of the line will radio for your child to be escorted to the car line. Please pull all the way forward until all cars stop and wait for your child to be escorted to your vehicle. For the safety of everyone, please remain in your vehicle. Do not get out of your vehicle at any time in the car line. Our staff will do our best to assist. Per the District, staff are not allowed to open and close vehicle doors. So please practice entering and exiting a vehicle safely with your child. These procedures include A-Team students. A-Team students will no longer be dismissed from the front of the school. A-Team students will be dismissed from the back of the school in the car line dismissal area. Car line arrival has not changed from last year's procedures. Students will be dropped off on the Eastside of campus and enter the through the PE door. A-Team students continue to be dropped off in the front of the school. A-Team parents are to park in a designated parking spot and escort their child to the drop off location by the exterior cafeteria door.

<u>Bus Dismissal Procedures:</u> All bus students will remain inside the building for bus dismissal. Bus students will be escorted to the main hallway by the front office and line up inside the building at their Bus letter/number. Once everyone has arrived, the bus students will be escorted outside by a staff member and loaded onto their bus. This includes aftercare transportation vehicles. <u>Bus arrival</u> has not changed from last year's procedures. Students will be dropped off at the front of the school and enter the building through the front doors.

<u>VPK (Voluntary Pre-K) Dismissal Procedures:</u> VPK students will be dismissed at 1:45 p.m. The VPK teacher and the classroom assistant will bring the students to the cafeteria to be dismissed out the exterior Cafeteria door. VPK parents will remain in their vehicle and the students will be called outside and escorted to the parent's vehicle. <u>VPK arrival</u> will be at the front of the school. Parents are to park in a spot on the Southside of the parking lot and then escort their child to the designated VPK drop-off location.

<u>Walkers & Bikers Dismissal Procedures:</u> Students who live on the Eastside of campus (Pembroke Isles Community), will be escorted out the PE door to walk around the perimeter sidewalk and exit the campus through the back gate by the bike rack. Primary students need to be handed off to a parent or guardian at the gate. Students who live on the Westside of campus (Silver Lakes Community), will be escorted out the front doors of the school to the bus area. These students will then walk north on NW 172<sup>nd</sup> Ave. to cross the road at the crossing guard. <u>For arrival</u>, walkers/bikers who live on the Eastside of campus will enter the building through the PE door. Walkers/Bikers who live on the Westside of campus will enter the building through her front doors of the school.

# **Dress Code**

## Panther Run has a mandatory school unified dress code.

All students attending Panther Run must adhere to this unified dress policy. Uniforms can be purchased through the school-approved dealer or at a local department store. The unified dress code consists of navy blue or khaki colored pants, skirts or shorts. Girls may choose to wear skorts or jumpers in these same colors. Polo shirts in navy blue, hunter green, or gray will be worn. The Panther Run PTA school tee shirt can also be worn. Cargo pants are not permitted. Students are permitted to wear jeans that fit properly and are not torn. Loafers, closed shoes or sneakers may also be worn. More information on school uniforms is available in the school office. Parents can apply for a waiver to the school uniform policy within the first ten days their child is enrolled at Panther Run, or within the first ten days of the beginning of every school year. Waivers are available in the front office. Student identification badges are part of the dress code and must be worn at all times on campus. Students are not permitted to wear suggestive, revealing or indecent clothing; including but not limited to clothing that exposes private body parts and/or displays pictures or words that have a sexual connotation. Hoodie sweatshirts, leggings and hats are not allowed to be worn in school.

# News from Food & Nutrition School breakfast & lunch are free for Panther Run Elementary students

Thanks to federal, state and local partnerships, Food and Nutrition Services are able to offer variety and well-balanced nutritious meals. The National School Lunch Program provides the student the opportunity of selecting a lunch consisting of 5 meal components (Meat/ Meat Alternate, Milk, Grain, 2 fruits or vegetables). The student may choose 3, 4, or 5 components for the same price. A student may refuse 1 or 2 of the meal components. The idea of "3 are good, 4 are better and 5 are best" is promoted to assure the greatest variety and nutrient intake. This is our government's way to assure that its financial support pays for only those meals that meet defined federal standards. School lunch meals provide an assortment of foods including entrée salads and fresh fruit daily. For students who prefer to bring a bag lunch, either low fat white, strawberry or chocolate milk, or water are available for \$.50 per carton. Ice Cream will be sold on Wednesdays for \$1.00. If a student does not select 3 of the 5 components offered as a meal, then the meal does not qualify for federal reimbursement and the student must pay ala carte prices. Students are charged a la carte prices for additional portions and for specialty items. Because of the government's support, choosing the school lunch meal is a real bargain. Please see the list of ala carte items and prices on page 14 of this newsletter. A couple items on the list will be sold daily based on availability. Therefore, not all items on the list will be sold every day. There are 47 schools in Broward County that do not qualify for Community Eligibility Program (CEP). These schools have been accepted for the universal free lunch pilot program. Under this pilot program, all students at Panther Run Elementary School will be receiving lunch for free. Breakfast is free District-wide for all students. Therefore we are highly encouraging parents to apply for the free & reduced meal benefit program this year. Students will bring home a Free and Reduced Price Meal application the first week of school. The United States Department of Agriculture provides free or reduced price meal to children whose families meet income requirements. This helps assure that all children have access to nutritious food during the school day. Children need proper nutrition to grow, be healthy and learn. Only one application is necessary per household. Information is secure and confidential. Noncitizens and non-residents may apply for benefits.
