- 3 standard wide-ruled Composition Journals
- 1 spiral wide-ruled notebooks
- 1 regular size plastic Pencil Box (No Zipper Pouches)
- 4 jumbo glue sticks
- 1 (2-pack, 3 oz. size) Play-doh \*any color is fine\*
- 1 pair of scissors (kid safe non-pointed)
- 2 boxes of 8 Large crayons
- 1 pack of "Expo" dry erase markers (various colors)
