# Fabulous Flamingo Academy Staff

The School Board of Broward County has background checked and cleared all staff members. Staff members also attend ongoing professional development. Ratios are 1:20 for grades K-5. All staff members have experience working with children in a group setting. Many of our staff members work at our school during the day.



# Safety & Security Procedures

## SUMMER ACADEMY & AFTER-SCHOOL ACADEMY

- \* Children are only signed out by people listed on the child's registration form.
- \* If an emergency occurs and that needs to change by phone, you must provide the password.
- \* Our campus is secured with a single point of entry.

## AFTER-SCHOOL ACADEMY

- \* Children are picked up from their classroom and safely taken with our staff members to the cafeteria, 5 minutes prior to other students being dismissed.
- \* Attendance is confirmed by 2:15 and we will be contacting you with any questions.

**2:40-3:00 - Handwashing, Snack (provided) and Social Time**

**3:40-4:20 - SPECIAL**

**4:20 - 5:00 - SPECIAL**

**5:00-6:00 - Lego and game cart**

# Before-School Academy Payments



- 2019-2020 Fee Schedule
- \$2.65 an hour 6:30am-7:30am daily
- 10 Payments (18 school days) \$48
- Children are released to cafe for free breakfast prior to going to start their day.



# The difference between our After-school program and other “daycare” based after-school programs . . .

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The children are grouped by age and participate in academic reteach and enrichment activities specific to their grade-level skills.

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Your child does not have to be transported daily by bus to an off-campus location. Many times daycare buses pick up at multiple schools and it may take up to 40 minutes for your child to get off the bus.

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If you are approved for free or reduced lunch, we can help you apply for a scholarship that can reduce your monthly payment by up to 50%.

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Every child in our program has technology time for a minimum of 30 minutes two times per week.

Summer price is \$150 per week with no additional fees for before or after care

Ages: Students enrolled in any Broward County Public School as incoming kindergarteners through students who completed fifth grade.

# Math

- Identify and recognize numbers to 20
- Counting to at least 50
- Base 10, ten frames
- Addition/Subtraction to 10
- One-to-One correspondence
- Ability to do simple sorting-color, shape, etc.

# Personal Skills

- State their first and last name
- State phone number and home address
- Unzip backpack, pants, and tie shoe laces
- Toileting skills
- Uses scissors, glue sticks, desktop/laptop/iPad/kindle appropriately
- Memorizes student number
- Knows birthday (MMDDYYYY)

- Grammar Focus: Verbs, Sensory Words, and Adjectives



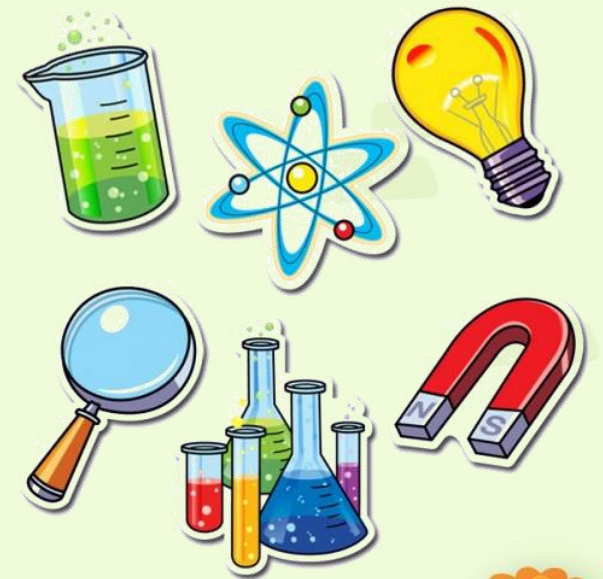
## ➤ Middle/End of Year Focus:
