SUBJECT: **NEW “REGISTER2RIDE” TRANSPORTATION INITIATIVE**

School bus transportation providers across the nation are experiencing challenges due to driver shortages. Broward is joining other school districts and implementing a new initiative that will require all students eligible for school bus transportation for the 2022/23 school year to register. The goal is to mitigate the driver shortage; create more efficient and effective routes; minimize daily route coverage, bus overloads, and improve arrival times.

Please inform students eligible for school bus transportation that to receive a bus assignment they **must answer the question** “Are you going to ride the school bus for the 2022/23 school year?”
