When PTE goes into a Rainy-Day Dismissal, my child is going to be dismissed the following way:

WE WILL ONLY STOP DISMISSAL IF THE LIGHTNING ALARM IS CALLED. At that time, we will not be dismissing anyone until the ALL CLEAR is given. When we do dismiss once the ALL CLEAR has been given, we will dismiss using the Rainy-Day Dismissal choice you have listed above.

If your child is a walker or biker, you should have them carry appropriate rain gear in their backpack.
