What will the 1st day of school look like?

The warning bell will ring at 9:25am for students to report to their 1st period class. Students will report to all 8 classes on day one only. Student locators will be posted around campus for students to find their 1st period classroom or they can look up their schedule on Virtual Counselor.

Where can I find the bell schedule?

What do I do I have a question or concerning regarding transportation? When will I receive my bus card?

In addition, our transportation liaison, Ms. Parker, will be available during both lunches the 1st week of school for students who may have a question. Bus routes can be viewed via Virtual Counselor. BUS PASSES WILL NO LONGER BE MAILED HOME.

What do I do if there is an error with my schedule?

Visit our website, click on "Guidance," and scan the QR code to submit a concern form. School Counselors will also be available during lunches to answer questions.

How can I get involved in extracurricular activities?

Visit our website and click on the tab for Athletics and/or Activities for our list of sports, clubs and organizations. What do I do if I am not feeling well?

Please follow the guidelines stated by the School Board of Broward County. Students who have symptoms should remain at home. Students who have symptoms while at school should notify his/her teacher and the nurse will be contacted.

Do I have to wear an ID badge?

ID badges are mandatory for all students and staff while on school busses and on campus. The ID badge must always be current and visible. Students will take pictures via personalization class and receive (1) free ID badge and lanyard. If a student forgets or loses his/her ID badge, they should report to their grade level office. In addition, your ID badge will also be utilized while receiving meals on campus.

Should I wear my 2020-2021 ID badge until I receive my updated 2021-2022 ID badge?

Yes. Be advised that once ALL students have been issued an updated badge, students will be required to wear the updated badge.

Is there tutoring available for students who have academic concerns?

Yes. Broward Schools will continue to offer ask Bria. This is available via Clever. In addition, Nova High School will offer extended learning opportunities for students, which will be shared with all stakeholders.

How can I monitor my grades and attendance?
