Shoes	Cold Weather
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Sneakers, low heeled shoes (2 inches or less) or boots • enclosed toes and backs (suggested) 	<p>Sweatpants and sweatshirts in solid school colors will be permitted on days when the temperature falls below 60 degrees.</p>

Inappropriate Clothing
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • garments with slogans, emblems, motifs, stripes or patterns • oversized pants, shorts, or skirts • JEANS • Long oversized coats or jackets • Shirts or tops unbuttoned below the chest • Sweatpants, sweatshirts (unless weather permits) • Jogging or athletic attire • Tight fitting pants, tops, muscle shirts, tank tops, tube tops, undershirts • Tattered clothes, garments with holes, frayed pants, shorts, or skirts • Cutoffs, mid-drifts, unbuckled pants, shorts or skirts • Hats, caps, suspenders, chain belts • Flip-flops, slippers, high heels, platform shoes, stilettos. • Open toed or backless shoes are not recommended for safety reasons • Any item not in accordance with the Dress Code Policy of Broward County Public Schools.
