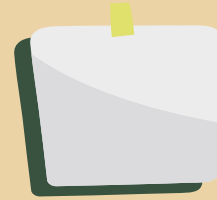
Congratulations Gustavo Zorrilla - Grade 7

At the risk of embarrassment, Lorenzo spoke up about the possibility of having lice. He was honest and forthright and behaved in a mature manner.

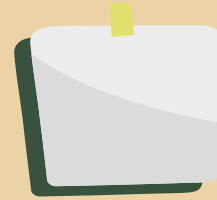
