VOLUNTARY PREKINDERGARTEN (VPK) PROGRAM INFORMATION

CLASSES BEGIN:

Monday, June 21, 2021

CLASSES END:

Monday, August 3, 2021

Note: No school on Monday, July 5, 2021.

DAYS & TIMES:

Monday – Thursday only 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Breakfast, lunch and snack will be provided.

SUPERIOR INSTRUCTION:

All District Summer VPK instructors hold a Florida Teachers Certificate with certification in Early Childhood Education.

SUMMER VPK ELIGIBILITY

The Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) 2021 Summer VPK program provides **face-to-face instruction only**. There is no online or eLearning option.

The free, BCPS Summer VPK program is available to children that turned 4 years old by 9/1/20, will be entering Kindergarten in the Fall and meet one of the following criteria:

- Did not use their VPK Certificate of Eligibility during the 2020-2021 school year

OR

- 5th birthday is after 2/1/21 and used less than 70% (378 hours) of their VPK Certificate hours during the 2020-2021 school year.

2021 Summer Voluntary Prekindergarten (VPK) Directions to Apply

To participate in any VPK program, parents/guardians must apply for, receive and submit a 2020-2021 VPK Certificate of Eligibility or 2020-2021 VPK Re-Enrollment Certificate of Eligibility. Follow the steps listed below.

Step 1: Obtain your child's 2020-2021 VPK Certificate of Eligibility or 2020-2021 VPK Re- Enrollment Certificate of Eligibility through the State's Family Portal. familyservices.floridaeearlylearning.com/Account/LogOn

Step 2: Apply for one of the schools below through the BCPS - VPK Parent Portal: browardschools.knack.com/broward-schools-poc#

Step 3: Check your email and/or the BCPS - VPK Parent Portal for application status.
