BEHS TARDY PROCEDURE 2019 - 2020

The tardy procedure begins on Monday, August 27, 2018 for <u>ALL</u> Blocks of the day, including first/fifth period.

The expectation is that <u>ALL</u> students be on time to <u>EVERY</u> class, <u>EVERY</u> day.

Procedures:

All late students, without a pass for a late sign-in:

<u>1ST AND 5TH PERIOD</u>

Before 8am—Admit to class, record TU on Pinnacle Excused Tardy—Record on Pinnacle as Present and record time arrived After 8am—Internal Suspension Do not admit students to class without a pass

DURING CLASS

TARDY #1:	Warning
TARDY #2:	Parent Notification
TARDY #3:	Detention for 30 minutes
TARDY #4:	Detention for 60 minutes
TARDY #5:	Referral to Administrator

Tardy Policy

In accordance with the District's Progressive Discipline Policy, students will be on time to class. Tardiness disrupts class instruction and also counts toward establishing a pattern of non-attendance that may indicate early signs of truancy. A pattern of non-attendance may be established by an accumulation of tardiness, absences (excused and unexcused), and early sign outs that exceed five (5) days in a marking period or ten (10) days in two (2) marking periods.

Class Cuts

It shall be the responsibility of the teacher to encourage regular and punctual attendance. If a student is absent from class and not listed on Pinnacle as absent, the teacher must consider the absence as a cut. Cuts should be treated as unexcused absences. Teachers should take appropriate disciplinary action: **contact parents**, and / or refer to guidance or an administrator.
