SAFETY UPDATES

All students and Hallandale faculty must wear school-issued ID's every day.

All visitors must report to the front desk for check-in. All visitors must have an ID to conduct business on campus. Upon entry to campus, all visitors must be processed through the STAR System. This includes parents, district staff, vendors, volunteers, and members of the public.

Emergency drills will be conducted on a monthly basis. Tornado, fire, and code red drills will be conducted within the first two weeks of school.
