All eligible students needing bus transportation for the upcoming school year must register for a bus assignment. Use the webpage below to register. If registering after July 15th, student transportation will be given by the 3rd week of school.

You can now track your child's bus by downloading the Here Comes the Bus app.



We will be utilizing Curbsmart for our car rider dismissal. You will receive a personalized family Curbsmart number. This should not be shared with anyone that is not authorized to pick up your child. This is how we match the student to the correct car. This year parents will be checking into Curbsmart to have their child released. You will receive additional information at Meet and Greet.



Secure the Next Generation Referendum Renewal

Broward County Public Schools (BCPS) is presenting voters with a referendum renewal that will appear on the August 23, 2022, primary election ballot.

The new Secure the Next Generation Referendum would increase voters' investment in education from a half-mill to one mill to continue securing funds for all public schools and will now also include charter schools

- Recruit & retain high-quality teachers and eligible staff by increasing compensation supplement
- Maintain and enhance school resource officers and school safety staff
- Maintain and enhance essential programs, such as mental health services

If the Secure the Next Generation Referendum is not renewed, funding for the items listed above will no longer exist.

Why does BCPS need to renew the referendum and increase to 1 mill?

The funds from the ½ mill referendum that voters approved in 2018 are set to expire. Those funds support over 500 school safety personnel, 100 mental health professionals, and approximately \$82 million in salary supplements for teachers and eligible staff, to compete with neighboring school districts.

On April 26, 2022, the School Board approved to, once again, present this referendum on the August 23, 2022, primary election ballot, with an increase to one mill, for voters to consider investing in Broward County Public Schools.

This renewal would provide BCPS with the ability to compete with neighboring school districts (Miami Dade County Public Schools, presenting an increase from the current .75 mill to one mill, and the School District of Palm Beach County Public Schools is currently at one mill), and to account for new legislation that now requires the District to share nearly 20% of these funds with charter schools.



Riverglades After Care Registration applications will be available to parents starting on July 12, 2022.

Please be advised that just because you have completed the application doesn't mean you have been accepted into the aftercare program.

You will receive TWO emails once your application is submitted. The first one will say you have completed the process (THIS IS NOT YOUR ACCEPTANCE EMAIL). The second email will inform you that you have been accepted OR placed on our waiting list.

Please do not make any payment until you receive the second email saying your child has been accepted.

- Step 1: Make sure you are on a computer using Google Chrome as your internet browser.
- Step 2: Go to www.browardschools.com/bascc
- Step 3: Scroll down until you see "Registration for Before and After School Child Care... Click Here" button
- Step 4: Scroll down and select Riverglades Elementary as your school
- Step 5: Make sure you have selected Riverglades Elementary. Then, click on the paper and pencil icon under "click below to register for child care"
- Step 6: Review Parent Handbook
- Step 7: On the upper right-hand corner select the down arrow and select Riverglades Elementary. Then, click green GO button.
- Step 8: Select "New Application 1st Time Click Here"
- Step 9: Complete the application
