STMS Unified Dress Code



The Silver Trail Middle unified dress code consists of the following clothing items:

- Cotton knit, short sleeve polo shirts in solid white, black, teal, and gray. The school logo on a polo shirt is preferred. Undershirts if worn must be short sleeve and white only.
- Cotton blend straight-leg pants secured at the waist. Color choices are black, khaki, & gray.
- Shorts, capris, and skorts must not be shorter than mid-thigh and secured at waist. No athletic shorts allowed. Color choices are black, khaki and gray.
- Plain blue, black and gray cotton denim jeans secured at the waist. Jeans must be solid color with no tears, rips, or large print words or images. Also, spandex or nylon jeans/Cargo pants and cargo shorts are not allowed.
- Cold-Weather/Outerwear must be a plain and open-front (zipper or buttons) jacket (e.g. windbreaker, sweatshirt, sweater).
- No brand labels, logos or other printed words or images are allowed. Color choices are solid, (one-color only) white, teal, black, or gray. SPECIAL NOTE:, Any version (old or new) of the school logo is acceptable.

Get ready for the back-to-school season with these School Bus Safety Updates & Tips for Students, Parents and Commuters!

- If a student is eligible for transportation services, their bus route will be posted on Virtual Counselor.
- Expect school bus delays the first few weeks of school due to traffic congestion around campuses, schools regulating dismissals, and students becoming familiar with their bus drivers.
- Students should arrive at the bus stop 10 minutes early.
- Major bus stop changes will be considered after September 2nd so routes can be stabilized and leveled.

SCHOOL SAFETY



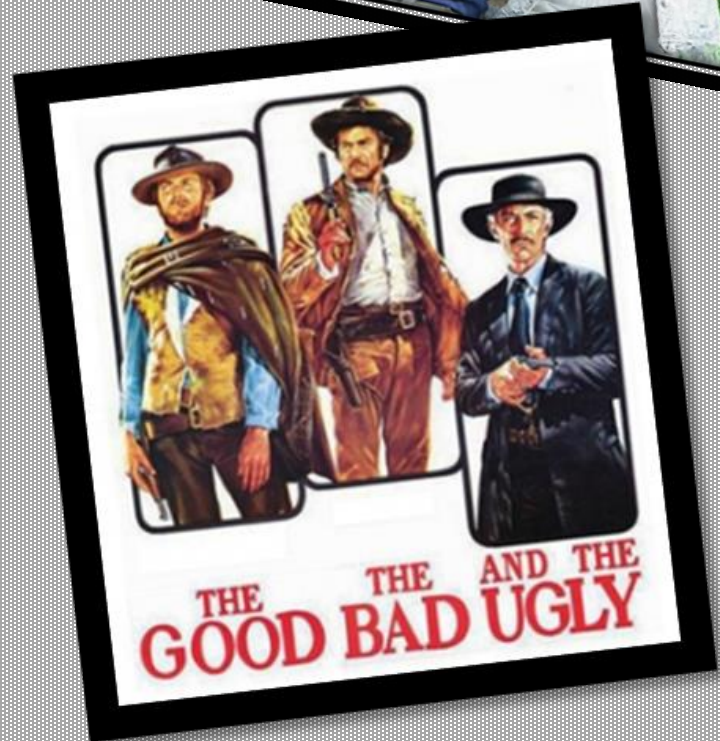
- ✓ As a part of our safety procedures for the 2021-2022 school year, we will be conducting monthly emergency and evacuation drills, in coordination with local police and fire rescue to better prepare in the event of a true emergency.
- ✓ In addition, all students are required to wear their IDs at all times while on school campus. At the beginning of the year students will be required to use IDs from the previous school year until new ones are issued.

The safety and security of our students, staff and parents is our top priority.
