- All credits count towards graduation and all grades will be on your transcript (must maintain a 2.0 unweighted GPA or higher to graduate)
- More academic classes and electives to choose from

- 40 Hours of community service required for graduation

## **Schedule Change Process**

- Schedule Change Request Forms: The forms for course changes will be given out during 1st period on the first day of school. Core class changes will be the first priority.
- Fill out the form completely and accurately.
- Deadline to submit a schedule change request is 8/23/21 – NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Response will be provided by your form being returned to your 1st period class with either a new schedule if a change is granted or a denial.
- Please be aware that online systems take 24-48 hours to update a change.
