Procedures and Rules

AGENDA BOOKS: Agenda books keep your child aware of important dates/homework assignments, and are used as a communication tool between the teacher and the parent. Please check your child's agenda booklet daily.

ATTENDANCE: Attendance at school often determines pupil progress. Students should attend school daily and arrive on time. In the event of an absence, a call is required beginning with the first day and continuing with all subsequent days. Attendance at the moment is based on attendance to live sessions in TEAMS.

Remember, the IMT (Information Management Technician must be notified of your child's absence within 48 hours of the absence. Please make sure you call: 754-323-5652.

CONFERENCES: At the moment conferences will be done over the phone or through TEAMS. Conferences ensure better understanding among the teachers, students, and parents. A parent or teacher may request a conference at any time. Please call the school to arrange for a convenient time to talk to your child's teacher. At the time during virtual learning the hours are 7:40 a.m. – 8:10 a.m. and 2:10 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. for conferences.

DROP-OFF/PICK-UP AREAS: PHASE 2-Students arriving on campus walking or by car will come through the main entrance. Parents will NOT be allowed to come out of their cars and will not be allowed to come onto campus.

For the safety and to minimize many entrances and exits students, parents are asked to enter and exit on the east side of the school, (entering from Harbour Blvd.)

Late drop off-will be off Fairway Blvd and must check in with campus monitor before parking.

Students may be dropped off from 7:45 - 8:10 a.m. Grab and Go breakfast will be provided if needed.

Dropping off students in the Bus Loading Zone is **prohibited**.

GATES CLOSED AND LOCKED: : (This will be the process when we return to campus)

The gates in the bus loop will be open from $\underline{7:45-8:10}$ for buses **only**. After 8:10 all gates will be locked.

If your child arrives late to school, he/she must be escorted by an adult and signed in at the front office. If you need to enter the campus any time after 8:10 please enter the campus from Fairway Blvd. where our Campus Monitor will be located.

EARLY RELEASE DATES: Early Release Days are designated by the School Board of Broward County. On the following days students are dismissed at 12:10 pm:

October 9th, 12, 16th, January 7th, February 18th, March 18th, April 8th, & June 9th

HOMEWORK: Children are encouraged to study at home. Setting aside a definite time each evening for homework will develop good work habits. Routine study time is an excellent plan, particularly if it is done with a parent in a relaxed and positive setting. The classroom teachers will assign homework. However, at this time all homework will be done virtually with the teacher prior to 2:00 p.m.

INTERIM REPORTS: An interim report is sent home half-way through a reporting quarter to notify parents of progress. If you want to request a conference, or if the teacher requests a conference, please call the school to arrange a convenient time.

PARENT-TEACHER Organization (PTO): We welcome and encourage your assistance in providing guidance and service to our students, staff and community; including your attendance and participation at PTO meetings, School Advisory Council, and many more activities to come.

SCHOOL DRESS CODE: (When face to Face) School Uniforms are MANDATORY at Fairway Elementary. It is very important that students are in their uniforms every day. **Students MUST wear an ID badge every day.** Parents will be notified if your child isn't in compliance with the dress code policy.

SCHOOL SAFETY: Safety is a major priority at Fairway. We have established policies to ensure the safety of our students, staff, parents, and visitors.

It is important to understand that everyone's safety is compromised when the policies are not followed.

- All visitors are required to report to the front office prepared to show I.D. before entering the school for any reason. Everyone must go through our RAPTOR system.
- Parents are required to show I.D. before entering the school for teacher-parent conferences, academic awards or "Moving On" ceremonies.
- Students are not allowed in the school building before 7:40 am. If your child would like breakfast, he/she must be in the breakfast line from 7:20 a.m. to 8:00 a.m.
- Any change in a student's usual dismissal procedure must be reported to the student's teacher in writing prior to the change taking place.
- Please note that we will be conducting monthly fire drills and Code Red Drills as part of our district safety mandates.

How to Work With Your Child's Teacher

- Get to know your child's teacher(s). The earlier the better for transparent communication. Don't wait for a special program if there is a problem or if your child has any special needs. It helps teachers to know everything they can about your child.
- 2. **Share important information.** This can make it easier for teachers to understand your child. Sometimes things that happen at home can affect student learning.
- 3. **Find out what's expected**. Ask about homework and other special assignments.

Grab and Go Meals

Tuesday and Thursday from 9-10 a.m. Fridays students be given meals at dismissal. Students or their parents will be able to pick up multiple meals at a time by driving to the Intermediate Car Pick-up area (at the large aluminum gate). It is strongly recommended that students or their parents pick up student meals at their home school for ease of service. Parents must have identification for their student to pick up meals if the student is not present. Recommended forms of identification include student ID's, report cards, and birth certificates. Identification must be present at each meal service. Broward County Public Schools offers Universal Free Breakfast for all students. Meal prices for lunch will be based on each student's meal eligibility status.
