

### REGISTRATION INFORMATION Windergarten! ... here come!



- -WHAT DO I Bring?
- 2 PROOFS OF RESIDENCE: Primary Proof (column A) and SECONDARY PROOF (COLUMN B) OF RESIDENCE (SEE REGISTRATION PACKET FOR WHAT IS ACCEPTED)
- COMPLETED REGISTRATION FORM AND EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM
- OFFICIAL BIRTH CERTIFICATE
- FLORIDA IMMUNIZATION FORM (From Physician or Health Dept.)
- FLORIDA HEALTH EXAM (Dated WITHIN one year)
- Latest **report card** of **transcript** (if applicable)





### SCHOOL HOURS

- Regular SCHOOL Days 7:30aM -2:00PM
- **Early Release Day** 7:30aM- 12:00PM (Feb. 14)
- Breakfast (FREE) 7:30am-7:50am in the cafeteria
- **LUNCH** (FREE), Wednesdays/Fridays \$1 (Ice cream/Fruit bars)
- TARDY AFTER 8:00am, MUST SIGN CHILD IN AND GET "TARDY PASS"
- **LUNCH** TIMES Vary by Teacher/8rade Level 10:00am-12:30pm
- **NO DROP OFF PRIOR TO 7:30am** (NO ADULT SUPERVISION)
- ASP- available until 6PM
- Early Release- no later than 1:30PM! MUST BRING ID!
- PICK UP BY 2PM



### ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL

- DROP OFF- Car LOOP Between 7:30am-8:00am
- NO DROP OFF IN THE PARKING LOT!
- NO DROP OFF IN THE BUS LOOP!
- BUS RIDERS- Dropped off/Picked up in Bus loop
- CAR RIDERS/PICK UP- Car LOOP, HANG SIGNS FROM REAR VIEW MIRROR OR FRONT WINDOW
- NO STUDENT PICK-UP IN THE PARKING LOT NOR BUS LOOP!!!
- EXCESSIVE LATE PICK UP May result in referral to the social worker and/or pembroke park PD/BSO
- Refer to **Florida Statute 1003.31**
- CANNOT CHANGE DISMISSAL OVER THE PHONE, MUST WRITE A NOTE TO TEACHER(S)
- car rider, bus rider, walker, aftercare







### THINGS TO NOTE!



- BITTHDAYS- CAN Bring cupcakes/drop off in office for lunchtime distribution, no balloons, no parties in cafeteria or classrooms
- MUST Bring government issued id to visit the office, sign a child out/in or when attending functions at school such as awards ceremonies, daytime events
- Beginning of Year Forms-Download focus APP -
- EMERGENCY CONTACT FORMS- FILL OUT COMPLETELY! ANYONE WHO IS AUTHORIZED TO PICK UP YOUR CHILD-FILL OUT FIRST AND LAST NAME/PHONE
- UPDATING PHONE NUMBER OF ADDRESS? MUST NOTIFY THE OFFICE AND MAKE THE CHANGE IN PERSON!
- Send a Note for Change of Dismissal or if you plan on Picking up your child early from school so that they are ready
- PACK A RATNCOAT AND EXTRA CLOTHES IN BACKPACK!



## ABSENCES, EARLY SIGN OUT - CALL





- Call in absences to the **attendance line 754-323-6352** or write a note to the teacher, bring in doctor's note when appropriate
- CHECK THE **CODE OF STUDENT CONDUCT HANDBOOK** FOR acceptable excused absences and the full BCPS attendance policy
- EXCESSIVE ABSENCES MAY RESULT IN REFERRAL TO SOCIAL WORKER AND/OR LETTER FROM THE STATE ATTORNEY'S OFFICE (COURT)
- Early sign out minutes add up to days of absence (360 minutes=1 day)
- NO RELEASE OF STUDENTS AFTER 1:30PM
- ONLY THOSE LISTED ON THE EMERGENCY CONTACT FORM WILL BE ABLE TO HAVE STUDENT RELEASED TO THEM





# THINGS PARENTS CAN DO TO HELP YOUR CHILD BE SUCCESSFUL IN SCHOOL

- READ TOGETHER (PEAD ALOUD BOOKS, PEAD SIGNS ON THE STREET, PEAD AT GROCERY STORE/POINT OUT LETTERS AND THE SOUNDS THEY MAKE)-DEVELOPS READING SKILLS
- EXPOSURE TO DIFFERENT BOOKS (80 TO LIBRARY)
- TALK TO YOUR CHILD (DEVELOPS OR LANGUAGE)
- LIMIT TIME ON COMPUTER OF WATCHING TV OF VIDEO GAMES
- PLAY BOARD GAMES
- **Provide other experiences when possible** (going to the park, the beach, the store, a play, a movie, a restaurant)
- MONITOR ELECTRONICS, CELL PHONE USE, COMPUTER USE
- **communicate** with the teacher/school
- Read all interims carefully, ask questions if needed
- STAY aware of what is going on in school, participate when possible
- Parent link emails, texts, calls -stay updated on focus!




### REPORT CARDS/INTERIMS/CONFERENCES

- REPORT CARDS 80 HOME 4 TIMES A YEAR, ONCE PER QUARTER
- Interims 80 Home Midway through each quarter and/or when the teacher deems it necessary to discuss difficulties or areas of concern
- KINDERGARTEN- **Brades of 1, 2, or 3**
- TWO (2) CONFERENCES ARE REQUIRED EACH SCHOOL YEAR-MINIMUM
- Parent can request conferences by writing the teacher (email, note, communication folder), calling the front office to leave HIM/Her a message, or communicating directly with the teacher
- AVAILABLE ON FOCUS (DOWNLOAD THE APP!)











### KINDERGARTEN TESTING



- SIGN UP FOR PRE-TESTING WHEN YOU REGISTER YOUR CHILD FOR A SUMMER DATE (JULY/AUGUST)
- Letter names and sounds and concepts of print, writing, reading, numbers
- STATE TESTING DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR IS **ONLINE**, 3X & YEAR FOR F.A.S.T. and IREADY.
- Need **Headphones** (CHECK SUPPLY LIST PROVIDED)
- Need access to a device at home for iready

- KINDERGARTEN SUGGESTED SUPPLY LIST PROVIDED TO YOU TODAY
- Bring Supplies to the **Meet and Greet on Friday, August 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025**, labeled with your child's name (\*\*Check back with the school to find out what time it will begin)
