SUBJECT: 2004-2005 FIRST DAY HEAD COUNTS

First day student enrollment increased by 1,160 (.5%) this year rising to 246,063 students. Student enrollment increased at the high school, center and charter levels while decreasing at the pre-kindergarten, elementary and middle school levels. The student enrollment count includes all students who were in attendance at all schools, including charters and centers. Students enrolled at the College Academy at BCC begin classes on August 23, 2004 and will be included in the tenth day count. The highest percentage moves this year were evidenced at the high school level with an increase of 1,444 (2.3%) students, followed by the charter schools with an increase of 1,097 (1%) students. The table below depicts the number of students in attendance on the first day of school for the last three consecutive years.
