SUBJECT: **SUMMER 2005 - FIRST DAY GRADE THREE READING CAMP
COUNTS**

This memorandum provides the 2005 Grade Three Reading Camp student count data for the first day, June 8, 2005. As indicated by the attached table, each school participating in the Summer 2005 Reading Camp conducted a student head count by grade to reflect the number of students physically present on the first day.

Summer Reading Camp consists of third graders who scored Level 1 in FCAT reading. These students, denoted in the third grade column, will have the opportunity to be promoted at the end of Summer Reading Camp following their portfolio assessment.

The Summer Reading Camp Count on June 8, 2005 totals 1,860 students at 18 sites. This total does not include Year-Round School Reading Camp which begins July 5, 2005 at Colbert Elementary School.
