SUBJECT: **SUMMER 2006 - FIRST DAY GRADE THREE READING CAMP
COUNTS**

This memorandum provides the 2006 Grade Three Reading Camp student count data for the first day, June 5, 2006. As indicated by the table below, each school participating in the Summer 2006 Reading Camp conducted a student head count by grade to reflect the number of students physically present on the first day.

Summer Reading Camp consists of retained third graders who scored Level 1 in FCAT reading as well as third graders who were promoted but scored Level 1. Students, denoted in the third grade column, will have the opportunity to be promoted at the end of Summer Reading Camp following their portfolio assessment.

The Summer Reading Camp Count on June 5, 2006 totals 1,154 students at 15 sites. This total does not include Year-Round School Reading Camp which begins June 23, 2006 at Lake Forest Elementary.
