SUBJECT: 2012-13 TENTH DAY STUDENT ENROLLMENT COUNTS

The tenth day student enrollment, including both District and charter schools, is 260,480 as of Tuesday, September 4, 2012. Enrollment not including charter schools is 227,169. This represents a decrease of 1,535 from last year's tenth day enrollment of 228,704. Charter school enrollment is 33,311, which represents an increase of 4,111 from last year's tenth day enrollment.

Table 1 presents a comparison of last year's and this year's tenth day enrollments at Broward County public prekindergarten, elementary, middle, high and center schools, as well as charter schools. This student enrollment count includes all prekindergarten through twelfth grade students who were in attendance at least one day and have not withdrawn.

An accurate comparison between the first and tenth day enrollment count is not possible since the enrollment is reported differently. The first day student enrollment count is a head count of students who are physically present in class on this day. The tenth day student enrollment count reflects students who are registered and have attended at least one day of school this current school year.

Historically, tenth day enrollment has closely aligned with twentieth day enrollment and this year follows that trend with the tenth day enrollment being slightly lower (99.3%) than the projected twentieth day enrollment as shown in Table 2. District staff anticipates that there will be little difference between the tenth and twentieth day counts.
